- **Advocacy Program:** This program is aimed at advocating for policies that promote the interests of marginalized communities especially women.
- **Research & Evaluation Program:** This program conducts research studies to identify gaps in healthcare delivery systems as well as evaluate the impact of our programs on target populations.
