The passion that drives our mission was born from the experiences of gender inequality, inaccessibility to Sexual and Reproductive Health Services which includes but not limited to HIV Testing Services, Cervical Cancer Prevention Services and others STIs as well as limited access to prevention of gender based-violence interventions, mental health services, personal Economic Sustenance opportunities. It is also our key mission to contribute towards reduction of stigma and discrimination rate of people living with HIV/AIDs (PLHIV) and the people affected considering that aforementioned factors are contributory to high morbidity and mortality rate of women in the society.
